# PERFORMANCE NOTES

## General Notation

- \* Extended slurs over a note or a tremolo indicate sustain of that note or tremolo.
- \* In senza misura sections, accidentals apply to adjacent pitch. Accidentals are also maintained through notes beamed together.
- \*In measured sections, accidentals carry through the bar.
- \*Boxed notes are to be played like a fast tremolo, but in random order

#### Bass Clarinet Notation

- \*Bisbigliando (bisb.) Microtonal trill or tone-color trill
- \*Notes with Roman numeral above them: refers to split-tone "zones," from low sounding
- (I) to extremely high sounding (V).
- <sup>6</sup> Slap tongue
- Normal air level in pitch
- Pitch somewhat airy
- O Very airy sound
- → Gradual shift from one state to another
